Petersfield Photographic Society is a member of the Southern Counties Photographic Federation (SCPF) which is affiliated to the Photographic Alliance of Great Britain (PAGB).

How we use your information

To enable Petersfield Photographic Society (PPS) to operate, we collect personal information such as name, contact details, photographic distinctions and records of entries to events. We use this information to:

- communicate with you
- identify you as the author of images you produce
- enable you to compete in club and external competitions
- enable the provision of services to members such as the members' handbook and the members-only area on our website
- compile historical archive records

PPS website

If you request a login and password for the society's website, you must share your name and email address with the site. You may add personal information to your account at your discretion. We don't use or share this information but it will be visible to other members logging in to the site.

Our website collects cookies in order to operate correctly. Cookies don't contain any personal information and our visitor statistics are anonymised. Visitors can choose to decline cookies at any time via their internet browser.

Data security

- The society takes reasonable measures to ensure the accuracy and safe keeping of the data we hold
- Subject to the keeping of records as archives, PPS will delete members' personal information within two years of that individual ceasing to be a member
